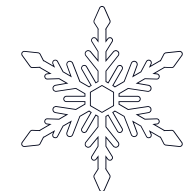

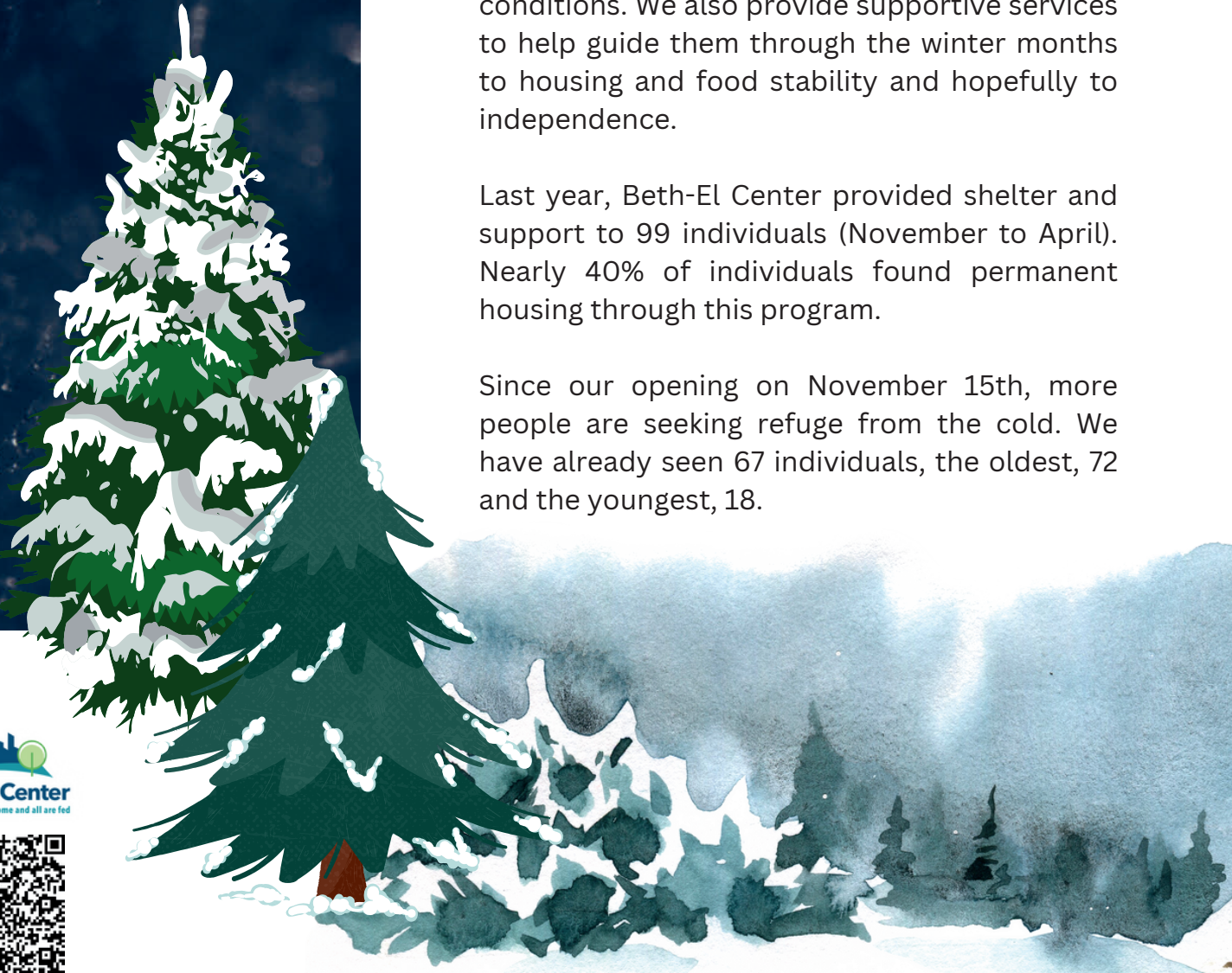
YEAR END UPDATE

No Freeze Winter Shelter

Beth-El Center has already begun its operation of a Warming Center in the Community Kitchen Dining Hall to help the unsheltered in our community. We not only provide a warm place to escape the frigid weather, but also offer free food and hot beverages to our guests. This program, made possible through the generosity of our Donors, offers a safe and welcoming place for our most vulnerable children, families, veterans and individuals during the harshest of conditions. We also provide supportive services to help guide them through the winter months to housing and food stability and hopefully to independence.

Last year, Beth-El Center provided shelter and support to 99 individuals (November to April). Nearly 40% of individuals found permanent housing through this program.

Since our opening on November 15th, more people are seeking refuge from the cold. We have already seen 67 individuals, the oldest, 72 and the youngest, 18.
